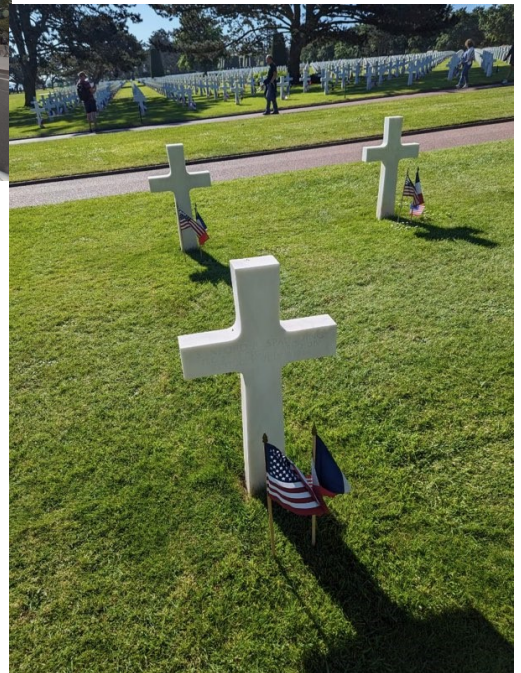


D-Day The 80th Anniversary
