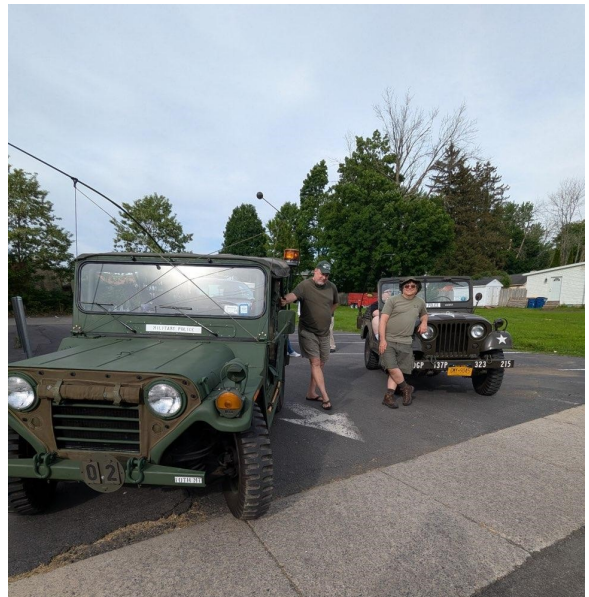

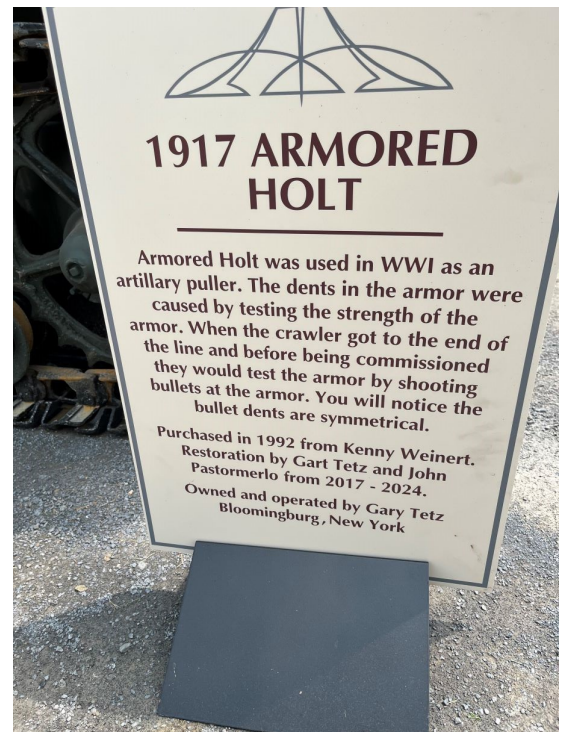
## *Gas-Up, Gallupville, NY June 7-8 & 14-15, 2025*
