NY-Penn Holiday Party









The military display is from a former paratrooper and was a separate display in the museum.












You stay ON SITE within walking distance of Omaha beach in military tents. All meals are provided by a chef in the mess hall, and transportation to sites is in original WWII vehicles. They are a not-for-profit, so the approximate \$2,600US covers lodging, meals, transportation in Normandy, and museum admittance. This is an incredible savings for a 10-day all-inclusive tour.
